


Q to nucleus box

4 New Queen will develop. Old Queen as spare or to produce brood for other colonies

1 Set up a stand & floor at least 1.5 meters away

3 Leave 1 Q-cell in new box add new combs or foundation.

2 Move Q and one frame of sealed brood to nucleus box with nurse bees (shake extra off other frames) and 2 frames of stores to the new position




Pagden method 1 Don't panic! 5 Replace Qex and supers feed if no flow (both colonies) remove bottom 2 Set up a stand Qex once Q laying & floor at least 1.5 meters away 4 Qex on bottom Put Q in new 3 Move all the brood box add new and nurse bees to the combs or new position, leave 1 or foundation. 2 Q cells NO Q-cells in here DBKA + BBKA CiC

3 Move all the brood and nurse bees to the top, leave 1 or 2 Q cells remove btm Qex once old Q is laying (1week)

2 rebuild hive with entrance above Qex facing a *different* way to original

Demarree

- Once new Q is hatched mated and laying can remove old Q and reunite
- Can split the tower and move top Brood box and Q-cell before hatching
- · Can't find the Q?
 - With Qex on floor and Brood box in place with some comb/foundation
 - Shake/Brush ALL bees into bottom box
 - Rebuild stack with Brood frames in top box max 2 Q cells
 - Nurse bees will go up to tend brood
